A five week campaign aimed at activating Glasgow's hospitality industry to apply circular design for food principles

- 41 participating restaurants
- Over 4000 circular dishes sold
- 40% introduced new sustainability training for staff
- 88% to keep their campaign dish or drink on menu
- 92% willing to participate in similar collaborations




# 2. Circular Startup Index
